



Alpine Trail and Open Space Ethics

(with excerpts from the Trail Ordinance)

Know Before You Go

- Know the regulations and concerns where you travel.
- Trails are closed from Dusk to Dawn except in City Park and sidewalk trails.

Choose the Right Path

- Avoid using/damaging trails when they are very wet.
- Motorized vehicles are only allowed on selected roads in Lambert Park and these roads are closed from Dusk to 7:00 am.
- If you travel in Forest Service areas: No vehicles (including bikes).

Dispose of Waste

- Pack it in. Pack it out. Pick up trash when you find it.
- No dumping or discharging of waste allowed anywhere.
- Leave the trails better for your passing.

Leave What You Find

- Do not remove rocks, plants, flowers, etc. from any open space.
- Do not remove, alter, injure or destroy trails or natural resources.
- Changes to trails within Alpine City must be approved by the City.
- Nothing will be constructed or placed to restrict the trail right of way.

No Alcohol, Fires or Fireworks

- Fires, fireworks, smoking and illegal drugs are prohibited in the Trail Corridor.
- Discharge of any weapons is prohibited.
- Possession or consumption of alcohol is prohibited on the Trail Corridor.

Respect Wildlife

- Do not feed or leave food for animals.
- Do not disturb wildlife.
- All dogs must be leashed except in Lambert Park (where they must be under strict voice control).

Be Considerate of Others

- Stay on established , marked trails.
- Do not cut cross country where there are no trails.
- Try to prevent widening of trails.
- Bikers yield to Hikers; both yield to horses. Motorized vehicles yield to all.
- Do not enter private property.
- Do not place items that restrict the trail right of way.
- Keep noise level appropriate.
- Keep speed under control.
