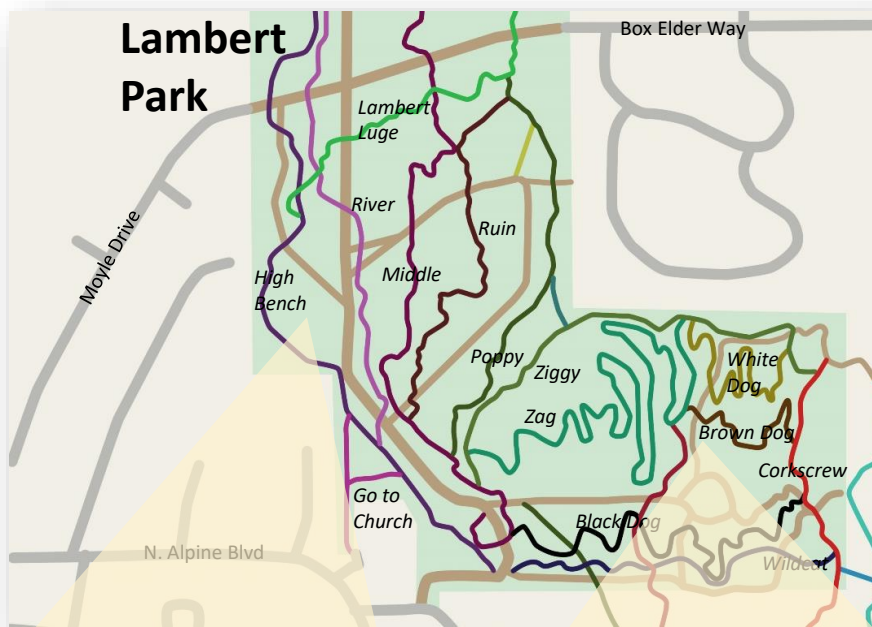
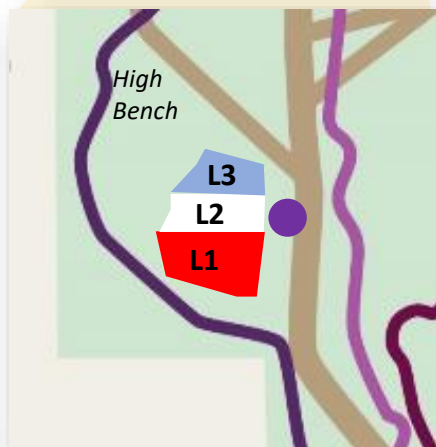


Lambert Park Winter Range Seedling Watering

Approximately 1100 various seedlings were planted in Lambert Park to improve the feeding area of the local wildlife. These plants will not survive unless they are watered.

Watering Information and Instructions:

- There are 2 sites to be watered (see map). Each site is divided into sections labelled with flags:
 - Middle/Upper Site (divided into 10 sections: M1, M2, M3, U1, U2, U3, U4, U5, U6, U7)
 - Lower Site (divided into 3 sections; L1, L2, L3)
- Water tanks and watering jugs are available at each site (please put the jugs back after use).
- There is a limited number of 5 gallon backpack pump sprayers available for loaning out. Please contact the Alpine Nature Center (alpinenaturecenter@gmail.com) for more information.
- Plants need to be watered every day (especially at the start of the summer).
- Watering amount: About 2 cups of water per plant; if using the pump sprayer at least 3 – 5 pumps per plant (the leafy plants should have 5 pumps).
